

MANLY VILLAGE PUBLIC SCHOOL 2016 UNIFORM POLICY

1. RATIONALE

- a. The Manly Village Public School Parents' and Citizens' Association (P&C) will aim to enhance the image and identification of the school by ensuring all students wear the correct school uniform.
- b. Manly Village Public School Parents' and Citizens' Association endorses the provision of the school uniform via a P&C endorsed school wear manufacturer/supplier, 'Pickles.'
- c. The P&C will ensure that the school uniform is reasonably priced and affordable through close liaison with the P&C endorsed school wear manufacturer/supplier.
- d. The Manly Village Public School Parents' and Citizens' Association will recommend the Uniform Policy to the principal, who will duly inform the staff and the wider school community.

2. IMPLEMENTATION AND AWARENESS

- a. All parents/guardians will be informed of the School Uniform Policy.
- b. All parents will be informed of details of the P&C endorsed school wear manufacturer/supplier.
- c. This information shall be relayed via the school's website, newsletter and through information given to parents upon enrolment.
- d. The Uniform Policy will be published in the school newsletter during the summer and winter months to remind parents of uniform requirements and to maintain a uniformity of appearance.
- e. The Uniform Policy will be made available on the school's website.
- f. A full photographic portfolio of the MVPS School Uniform will be held by the P&C endorsed school wear manufacturer/supplier for the school community to view and this will be amended as required by the P&C Association.
- g. The principal and school staff will be asked to assist in the implementation of wearing the correct school uniform.
- h. The principal and school staff will support the wearing of correct school uniform by positively reinforcing students wearing correct uniform, e.g.: uniform lotto, reminding students to wear correct uniform (individually or at assembly), and/or notifying parents (in person, in writing or by telephone).

There is no set time for wearing the summer and winter uniforms, however, a general rule would be for the summer uniform to be worn in Terms 1 and 4 and the beginning of Term 2, and the winter uniform to be worn from mid Term 2 to Term 3. The principal will advise parents of the changeover date in the school's newsletter.

3. AVAILABILITY

- a. The P&C currently endorses and supports the school wear manufacturer/supplier:

- b. The P&C operates a volunteer Second Hand Uniform Shop within the school premises.
- c. The Second Hand Uniform Shop will be stocked by means of donations of second hand school uniform items only.
- d. The Second Hand Uniform Shop will stock new school hats, and specific accessories.
- e. The costs of the new stock items will be met by through the P&C's General Account.
- f. Proceeds from the Second Hand Uniform Shop will be deposited into the P&C General Account.

4. SUMMER UNIFORM

GIRLS

Summer Dress:

Green, white and navy check poly cotton fabric dress (identified by fabric supplier, Young Apparel, as Cleoline Design 8302). The summer dress has two inverted pleats in the front and back, a green piping trim on the edge of a round collar and on the sleeves, a navy tab tie beneath the collar, and a zip pocket.

*** A long sleeve summer dress is available if pre-ordered, on individual basis.

OR

Summer Skort:

Green, white and navy check poly cotton fabric (identified by fabric supplier, Young Apparel, as Cleoline Design 8302). The wrap front skort has a zip pocket and adjustable elastic waist at the back.

WITH

MVPS White Short Sleeve Polo Shirt:

White polo shirt has two green stripes on the collar and a green school crest screen-printed on the front left hand side.

Plain Short White Socks

Black Leather Shoes

School Hat:

Navy poly cotton 'broad brimmed cricket' hat with green school crest.

***Girls may also wear the boy's uniform if preferred.

4. SUMMER UNIFORM (Cont.)

BOYS

Navy Blue Shorts:

Dark navy blue gabardine 'woven' fabric with zip pocket and elastic and draw cord waist.

WITH

MVPS White Short Sleeve Polo Shirt:

White polo shirt with two green stripes on the collar and a green school crest screen-printed on the front left hand side.

Plain Short White Socks

Black Leather Shoes

School Hat:

Navy poly cotton 'broad brimmed cricket' hat with green school crest.

5. WINTER UNIFORM

GIRLS

Winter Tunic:

Green, navy and black tartan poly serge fabric tunic (identified by fabric supplier, Young Apparel, as Clearon Design 9004). The tunic has a scoop neck, two inverted pleats front and back and a zip pocket.

OR

Winter Skort:

Made of a green, navy and black tartan poly serge fabric skort (identified by fabric supplier, Young Apparel, as Clearon Design 9004)
The winter wrap front skort has a zip pocket and adjustable elastic waist at the back.

OR

Navy Blue Pants:

Tailored stretch gabardine pants with a zip pocket and adjustable elastic waist at the back.

WITH

MVPS White Long Sleeve Polo Shirt:

White long sleeved polo shirt with two green stripes on the collar and green school crest screen-printed on left front.

OR

Girls White Long Sleeved Peter Pan Blouse:

White long sleeved buttoned play cotton front shirt with Peter Pan collar

Plain Black Tights OR Long Black Knee High Socks

Black Leather Shoes

School Hat:

Navy poly-cotton 'broad brimmed cricket' hat with green school crest.

***Girls may also wear the boy's uniform if preferred.

5. WINTER UNIFORM (Cont.)

BOYS

Tartan Winter Trousers:

Trousers made of a green, navy and black checked tartan poly serge fabric (identified by fabric supplier, Young Apparel, as Clearon Design 9004)
Trousers have an elasticized waist with a draw cord, a zip pocket and have a double knee up to size 12.

OR

Navy Blue Winter Trousers:

Made of a gabardine fabric, with elastic and draw cord waist and zip pocket.
They have double knee to size 12.

WITH

MVPS White Long Sleeve Polo Shirt:

White long sleeved polo shirt with two green stripes on the collar and the green school crest screen-printed on front left hand side.

Plain Black Ankle Socks

Black Leather Shoes

School Hat:

Navy poly-cotton 'broad brimmed cricket' hat with green school crest.

***Boys and girls can also wear the summer navy shorts in winter with white short socks.

6. SPORTS UNIFORM

GIRLS AND BOYS

Navy Blue Sports Shorts:

Unisex sports shorts made of microfiber fabric with an elastic and draw cord waist with zip pocket.

OR

Navy Blue Sports Track Pants:

Unisex track pants made of microfiber fabric on the outer layer and a single knit cotton lining on the upper leg and mesh lining on the lower leg. The track pants have an elastic and draw cord waist and a zip pocket.

WITH

Green MVPS Polo Shirt:

A green polo shirt with a white stripe on the collar and white school crest screen-printed on the front left side.

***A long sleeve green polo shirt is available, if pre-ordered, on individual basis.

Plain White Ankle Socks

School Hat:

Navy poly-cotton 'broad brimmed cricket' hat with green school crest.

SPORTS SHOES

Sports Shoes may be black or white.

Plain white or black are preferred but mostly white or mostly black are acceptable for sport. Black or white shoe laces are to be worn with shoes.

FOOTBALL SOCKS

Students playing PSSA rugby or soccer are encouraged to wear Manly Village Public School Football Socks on game days as part of the sports uniform.

Manly Village Public School Football Socks:

Knee high rugby socks, navy blue on the bottom, kelly green and white stripe top with 'Manly Village' in white around the green turn over.

7. HAT

Navy poly cotton 'broad brimmed cricket' hat with green school crest. The school hat is to worn to and from school and at all times in the playground.

NOTE: ***There is only one style of school hat.

8. JACKETS/PULLOVERS

The following combinations are available, and can be worn any season as required:

- a. **V-Neck Sleeveless Vest:** Navy blue fleece with green school crest screen-printed on the front left side.
- b. **V-Neck Drop Shoulder Jumper:** Navy blue fleece with green school crest screen-printed on the front left side.
- c. **Zip-Front Bomber Jacket:** Navy blue fleece with green school crest screen-printed on the front left side with a green stripe in the ribbing of the collar, cuffs and bask. The jacket has side pockets.
- d. **Quarter-Zip Jumper:** Navy blue polar fleece faced in green polo fabric around zip and collar and finished with a comfort seam; The jumper has a green school crest embroidered on the front left side with a draw-string hem with toggles, elastic in cuffs and front pocket.

9. FOOTWEAR

Plain Black Leather Shoes:

Black leather school shoes are preferred, but black runners are acceptable as long as the shoe and laces are black.

10. SCHOOL REPRESENTATION

Representation by students in school activities including sporting competitions will require all participating students to be in correct and full school uniform.

It shall be the responsibility of parents to ensure all students present for school representational activities in appropriate uniform and that attire specific to the activity is available to students, for example, PSSA. The school will supply attire such as, bibs, jerseys, stripes or skirts as required.

The principal and staff, in consultation with the P&C Association, is able to provide assistance to those families requiring support in wearing the correct school representative uniform.

11. ACCESSORIES

Hair accessories are to be navy, green, white or made of either of the two dress fabrics.

12. JEWELLERY

Jewellery is discouraged for safety reasons.


13. AMENDMENTS TO THE UNIFORM POLICY

Amendments to the Uniform Policy will be tabled, discussed and passed with a 75% majority vote at a General Meeting of the Parents' and Citizens' Association of Manly Village Public School, or by circular resolution, and ratified by the school principal.


14. UNIFORM REVIEW


This Manly Village Public School Uniform Policy 2016 was approved at the General Meeting of Parents' and Citizens' Association on May 9 2016.
